Dear ECLC Parents,

I write to inform the ECLC community of an exciting change to our Toddler Program which was approved at the most recent ECLC School Board meeting in early November.


Effective August 2012, ECLC will be accepting children who will turn 2 years old before September 1 of the school year. Currently students must be 30 months old to begin in the Toddler program. We feel this move will make ECLC more accessible to a wider group of children and provide more alternatives for the parents of 2 year-olds. Because of the lower entry age, we will also be relaxing the toilet training requirement for admission. We will likely be adding one assistant at the Toddler level to accommodate those children needing help with their bathroom needs.

Additionally, we will likely modify the classroom structure in order to provide additional options for parents wishing to enroll their child in this program. We plan to designate one classroom as a full day classroom for students to attend from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm. The other classroom will hold both a morning half day class from 9:00 am until 12 noon as well as an afternoon half day class from 12:30 pm until 3:30 pm.

It is our hope that these changes will allow more children to take advantage of the great educational program offered at ECLC.
