Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 4th May we will be holding our annual 'Fun Around the World' day and once again the event will be centered on 'Fun Sports'.

Time: 10.00 am - 12.00 noon followed by Family Picnic.
Place: **Jamwon Han River Park** (map will be sent home on Friday)

Requirements: All children except Toddler children are to come to school at the usual time 09.00 and go to their respective classrooms.
Toddlers- We request that parents bring their toddler child to the park by 9.45. We have found that this works much better for our smallest children.

What to wear?: Fun Around the World T-shirt, sports shorts, sports shoes, hat/cap (essential), and the girls wear their hair tied back. In the likelihood of hot weather, please ensure that your child/children wear an appropriate sun block and should it be cool, please ensure they have a sweatshirt.

My role as a Parent: Volunteer Dads /Parents to meet at Han River Park at 09.00 to help set up and have a final briefing!
Everyone else, valued spectators, necessary to cheer the kids on! Between 9.00-9.45 after a welcome and briefing the activities will **START at 10.00**

Format:
In a true around the world spirit there will be six activity stations representing six of the major continents around the world. The activities/Continents are Africa, Asia, South/North America, Oceania, and Europe.

The children, as a class, will participate in activities on a rotational basis. Each activity will last about 10 minutes. Each child will receive an acknowledgement of participation in the event at the end of the day.

Once the activities are over, we will all stay and have a picnic at the park. We would be very grateful for your help in this matter as this will not be catered for event. We request that you bring a picnic lunch for you and your children and a small rug/blanket for your family to sit on. In the event of heavy rainfall or high Yellow Dust measures, we will postpone the event until a further date but will certainly endeavor to hold the day as scheduled. Please note this is a half day school event. Once the activities are over, the children will join their parents and will become the responsibility of the parents.

We would like to have as many of the mums and dads attend and share a picnic with their children after the activities have ended. The school day will finish after the picnic so children will go home from the park with parents. If you are not going to be able to attend the event and anticipate any problem with picking your child up, please be sure to inform your child's class teacher well ahead of the day.
