HEALTH UPDATE: H1N1

Dear Parents,

I write with news of 3 more diagnosed cases of H1N1 at ECLC. Two are students in K1, Van Gogh – one of whom rides on Bus A and the other is not a bus rider. The other is a teacher in our Einstein Toddler class. All were positively diagnosed within the last 24 hours and have not been in school since Tuesday.


You may recall we also have another student who was diagnosed this past weekend as positive for Influenza A - which was assumed to be H1N1. She is expected back to school, upon doctor's approval, early next week.

I remain committed to being as transparent as possible with the parents regarding the health situation at ECLC. I will notify you when we have identified confirmed cases of H1N1. As stated in previous communications from me, it will be your decision as parent whether or not you want to send your child to school. We will remain vigilant with all our precautionary and preventative measures with the children at school.
