Dear Parents,

ECLC's 4th Annual Read-a-thon is a part of a bigger "Book Week" and will kick off Friday 12th March. The purpose of the Read-a-thon is not only to be a fund-raiser but also to be a fun and exciting opportunity for us to stimulate in our children an interest in books and encourage a life long habit of reading.

Please find below an outline of the schedule for this event:

Tuesday, March 9th

Pre-loved book sale - Attached to this form is a slip to be completed if you wish for your child to participate in purchasing books for Book Week. We have a range of second hand books for the children and parents to purchase for 1,000 won per book. The children will have the opportunity during the day to purchase a "pre-loved book". Parents wishing to get a book for themselves or have other siblings purchase books may come in to school and have a look any time after Tuesday.

Wednesday, March 10th

Students will receive packets which will include step-by-step instructions, a sponsor sheet and a reading log. During this first few days students will be asked to gather books to read and recruit sponsors who pledge a certain amount for each book read.

Friday, March 12th

Its time to READ, READ, READ! For a whole week students will keep track of how many books they read on their reading log. It doesn't matter whether students read to themselves, read to some one else, or have someone read to them. It all counts.

Monday, March 15th - Friday, March 19th

During this week, students bring in colored book strips indicating the name of each book read (included in your Read-a-thon packet). These strips will be added to the rocket to help the rocket move through space. The more books read, the further the rocket goes!

Students will turn in to school their completed sponsor sheets and reading logs along with the money they've collected.

Thursday, April 1st

During morning assembly, Andy will pass out certificates of participation. For lunch time, students will celebrate with a PIZZA PARTY! For those who go home at noon time, they will be given a cupcake during morning snack time.
