## Instructions

Dear Parents,

As with every PTA event, your support will be an invaluable component in the success of this year's Read-a-thon. Please contact me at [hermitage303@gmail.com](mailto:hermitage303@gmail.com) if you have any questions or concerns.

### **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March - Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> March**

- ✿ Look over the Instructions, Sponsor List and Reading List.
- ✿ Set reading goals and gather books to read.
- ✿ Ask your relatives and family friends to sponsor your child.
- ✿ Let your sponsors know how many books your child plans to read during the Read-a-thon. They can sponsor your child for every book or chapter read, e.g. KW100 per book or chapter, or a set amount for your child's participation, e.g. KW10,000 total.
- ✿ Add the sponsor's name and pledge to your child's Sponsor List.

### **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> March - Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> March**

- ✿ Read, read, read!
- ✿ Try to read every day. It doesn't matter whether students read to themselves, read to someone else, or have someone read to them. It all counts.
- ✿ Write down the name of the books read each day on the Reading List.

### **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> March - Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> March**

- ✿ Write down the total number of books read on the Reading List.
- ✿ Calculate the total due from each sponsor and collect the pledged donations.
- ✿ Write down the total collected on the Sponsor List.
- ✿ Place the completed Reading List, Sponsor List and money you have collected in an envelope.

### **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March**

- ✿ Send the envelope to school in your child's backpack and have them hand it to his/her teacher.

All students are encouraged to participate. Good luck and most of all have fun!
