The children will bring their artwork home this week with an order form and you can decide what you would like to order. The items will be custom made and delivered in time for the December holidays

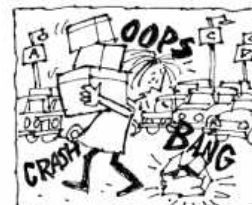

We are still responsible for customs duty and VAT which at 18% is included in the prices of the goods.

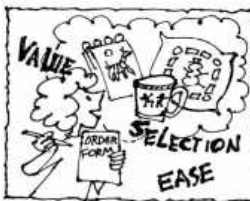

Order forms will come out in the next week.

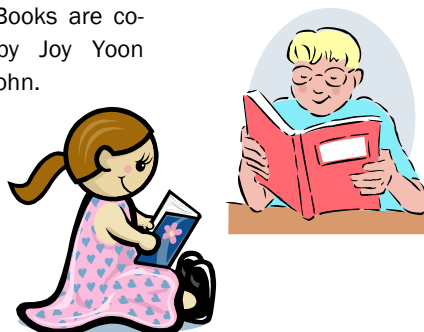


Scholastic Books
